Answers and Notes for Contracts 1-10

A Few Notes...

- There are 10 contracts in this set and they are available as either a PDF set (print) or as a MS Word version (allows contracts to be done on computer using MS WORD).
- Prices, distances and codes used in these contracts are not necessarily spot on (some have been made up, although I have tried to keep them as real as possible).
- Please note that although I take credit for the format and content of this resource, I do not take credit for the images used (clip art/internet).
- If these are being used as a class/group exercise, they could be enlarged to an A3 size to make them easier for a group to do/give more room to write in the boxes.
- If AMV is written on the answer sheet, this means that children's answers may vary, so no answer has been given for that particular question.
- Answers will vary for questions beyond question 23 as these will depend on amounts chosen by the student. Thus no answers have been provided beyond question 23.
- At the time of writing this resource, the NZ GST rate is 12.5%. However, as this changes later in 2010, the new rate of 15% has been used in question 25.
- Questions asking for total flight time does not include time on the ground. It only includes time in the air (time between departure and arrival times).
- #/s means Number/Numbers (Gate# = Gate Number)-I just didn't have enough room to fit the whole word in.
- Questions asking for stop-over/via times means time spent on the ground at those places (the time difference between arrival and departure times at the actual stop over place).
- DEST means Destination (on the Boarding Pass).
- AA written beside the flight numbers stands for Air Aotearoa.
- Prices listed for adult and child passengers are per person (pp). For example if it states 2 adults \$89.00pp, then the total amount due for 2 adults would be \$178.00.

- Cheque:
- No branch name has been given so the teacher/student could write in their own (perhaps using the town you live in).
 - They can decide who to pay as no specific airline has been used. Perhaps a different airline could be used for each contract.

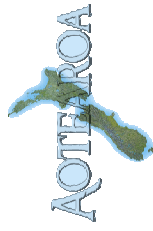
- Boarding Pass:
- Children could make up their own Bag Tag Numbers (No's) as none are specified in the contracts (this section has just been included to make the Boarding Passes as close to a real one as possible).

- All other information asked for can be found on the first page of the contract.

- When filling out the Boarding Pass, just count yourself as the only passenger for the information you need to fill out. NB: Only one seat number is used in the itinerary (even though there are more passengers in the scenario). This is the seat you use to list on your Boarding Pass.

As with any of my resources, there are no rules except for your own. Use them in any way which best suits you and your class/students.

I hope the resource is of use and the children enjoying doing the contracts.
