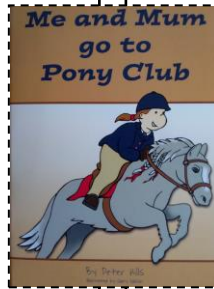

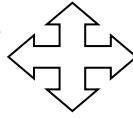

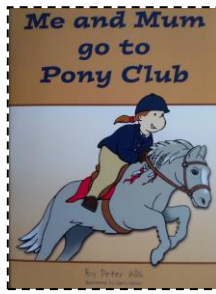


My Choice.
