Reliability

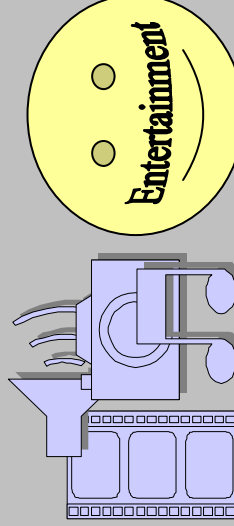
How can ones beliefs be reliable to one person, yet another person can say that you are unreliable?
