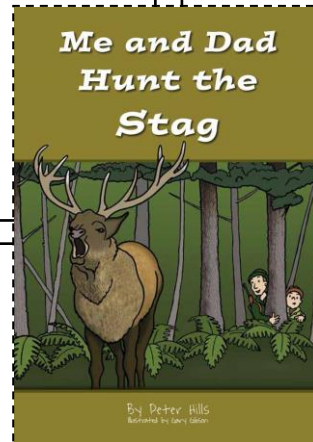


### Question Time (using the pictures).
