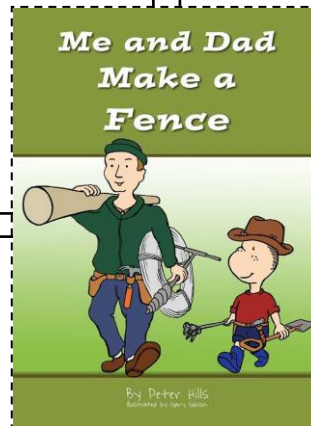
1. Who was singing?
