

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


Trace over the correct letters, and circle all the letters that are in the wrong place or not correct.



Match up then colour in/trace the words
















Using either fabric, or cardboard and felts, make up your own scarf with your own design. Try and be as creative as you can.

Write words from the story that start with the letters.




Using your own words, write your own sentence about something that happened, or that was in the book.
