

Task A (Revision of Task 7) - Word Processing Tasks. What do I need to do?

✓ With any tasks below, feel free to use things from the Task Bar menu, such as size, font, highlight, italic, colour etc.

- 1. Open a new document and name it.
- 2. Write a list of 10 different places, either in New Zealand, or just in the area that you live.
- Put these in a numbered list. You could either list them in alphabetical order, by size, location etc.
- Align the first 5 points in your list to the centre, and the 2nd 5 to the right.
- Highlight your even numbered list with one colour and your odd numbered list with another colour.
- Below your lists, write 1 sentence of why you listed your list of 10, in that particular order. Then highlight your sentence with a colour.
- Now using cut and paste, cut your sentence and paste it above your list of 10 points.
- 3. Practice using the Zoom button. Write a note at the bottom of your document, (before you share the document), to say that you have practiced using the Zoom button.
- 4. If you can print from your device, print out a copy of this document for your teacher.
- 5. Put your name, year level, school, classroom and the date on a new line below your work. Feel free to be creative here by using any of the skills that you have been learning from any of the task cards.
- 6. Share your document to me, (using the above email address). You don't need to share the document if you have printed it out for your teacher.
